Three giant torches (called Otebi) approximately 150kg in weight are carried up a series of shrine steps to the hall of worship in a display of fortitude and passion for tradition. This Shind ritual of fire that colors a single summer night orange and red in Tomonoura is one of Japan's three great fire festivals. Period: Night before the second Sunday of July







